Manfred Zimmel, Austria

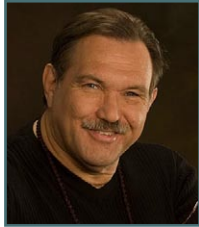

The Congress is held at the Hotel Phoenix at the heart of Copenhagen, Denmark (Bredgade 37, DK-1260 Copenhagen K. www.phoenixcopenhagen.dk). The hotel is situated 8 km. and 12 minutes by taxi from Copenhagen Airport (depending on the traffic). 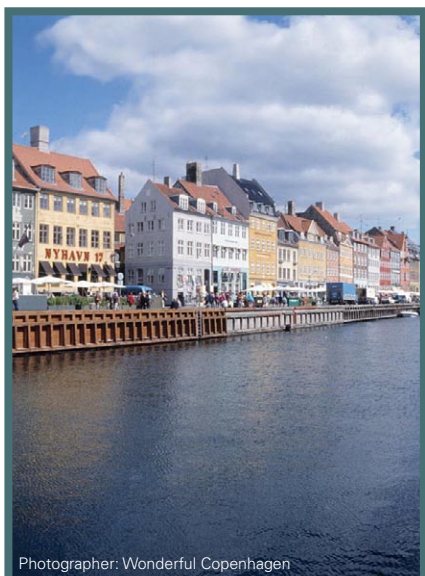
